# PROFILE

Dr. Cyrus Poonawalla International School (formerly known as Sou. Vijayadevi Yadav English Medium School), Peth Vadgaon, established in the year 2011 (affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi) is a Co-Ed School providing education from Nursery to Grade 12. It's a Boarding and Day Boarding School where students experience the joy of learning by doing, discovering and interacting. The school aims at holistic education and all round development of each and every student. It is located in a perfect environment for learning that enables students to grow as persons of character, competence, conscience, compassion and commitment. The academic units comprise Pre-Primary (Nursery - UKG), Primary (Grade 1 - 5), Secondary (Grade 6 - 10), Sr. Secondary (Grade 11 & 12), Olympiad Wing, NDA Preparatory Institute and IIT - Medical Academy. It is one of the petals of Shri. Shahu Shikshan Prasarak Seva Mandal, Peth Vadgaon, established in the year 1968 and stands as an epitome in the education field with great reliability of being a torch bearer to scale the path of knowledge.

The school has 16 acres of lush green campus, designed to create a paradise for the students to remain stress free and enjoy learning in fresh air surrounded with positive energy. Here, the utmost care is taken by making available all the modern amenities to the learner. The child centric pedagogy is executed ultimately leading to promote greater range of inquisitiveness.

Smt. Vijayadevi Yadav Pre-Primary School takes complete pastoral care where innocence is nourished and childhood is preserved. Here, children are fearless, enjoying their schooling without any biasness or threat. Various activities are conducted for the child's overall development like Puppet Theatre, Puzzles, Brain-Booster, Memory Game, Moral Stories, Swimming, Skating, Sand Play, etc. The 'Theme Tiffin' concept is executed which includes healthy food like cereals, vegetables, sprouted beans, etc. The Curriculum is based on Nine Intelligence of Howard Gardner.

The school provides Value Education with the help of Ramkrishna Math. The school has developed hands-on tools to inculcate moral values and to provide lessons of Patriotism, Obedience, Morality, etc. The school has maintained social accountability while imparting quality education. Various initiatives are taken to extend a helping hand to the Flood Affected Community, Old Age Home, Orphanage, etc. State-of-the-Art library is spread over 3250 sq. ft. and is thoughtfully designed to attract the students. The library records 69,000 online books where students, parents, teachers and all other stakeholders can enjoy the reading on one go.

Technology is rightly incorporated in the system that consists optic lease line, 4'x6' size touch screen, 24 x 7 Broadband availability, Web Portal, etc. Composite Science, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Social Science, Language, Math, Robotics, Computer and Art Labs are well-equipped to lure students for experiential learning. All-round development is achieved by making available the full time Special Educator, Doctor, Counsellor and Yoga instructor. Life Skills are promoted through practical engagement of students. Japanese language is taught to prepare the students for JLPT exams.

The school has natural turf play ground spread over 13 acres of area. It has 400 mtrs. running track, 350 mtrs. skating track and spacious grounds to create interest in sports activities and physical growth. Trained professional coaches provide proficient training of Badminton, Judo, Boxing, Rifle Shooting, Fencing, Yoga, Horse Riding, Skating, Football, Basketball, Athletics, Kho-kho, Running, Kabaddi & Cycling. There are well-maintained boys' and girls' hostels which are taken care by experienced Dorm Parents. This is nothing but a Home Away from Home.

Girls are taught self-defence techniques equipping them with confidence to deal with any circumstance. All the students are self-disciplined and obedient. Students get training of performing arts like music, dance, theatre, etc. The Hobby Clubs encourage students' talents and interest. Student Council is a democratically elected body which develops leadership qualities. The school also possesses its own organic farm and Desi Cowshed. Students are made aware of cultural, geographical and social diversity of other countries through video conference.

The IIT-Medical Academy and the NDA Preparatory Institute provide ample opportunities to soar high beyond the horizons. The students prepare for exams like MHCET, JEE & NEET and practice for the oral, written and physical tests daily as a part of NDA and other equivalent exams. 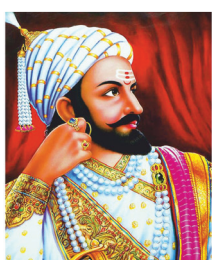
